Getting Started

There are endless ways to fundraise for AQ! Consider ideas that align with your personal style, interests, and the time you can dedicate. Choose an activity that is enjoyable for you, as your enthusiasm will inspire others to rally behind you and lend their support. Once you've got your event idea ready to go, if you have not done so already, please register to fundraise online.

Activity Ideas

- Curate a collection of items or experiences for an online auction.
- Organise a community cake stall where individuals can contribute homemade treats. Sell the goodies at local markets, schools, or online.
- Collaborate with local businesses to organise a workplace challenge, such as a team-building event or a friendly competition.
- Encourage participants to set fitness goals (e.g. running a certain distance, doing a set number of push-ups) and seek sponsorships for their achievements.
- Arrange a craft workshop where participants pay a fee to learn a new skill or create something special.
- Collect donated books and organise a sale at a local venue.
- Ask your workplace, or your child's school/kindy to hold a free-dress day where everyone brings a gold coin donation.

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Managing Funds

Online donations

If you have set up an <u>AQ fundraising page</u>, all online donations made to your page will be automatically receipted (how easy!). These funds will be transferred to AQ in your name, added to your grand total, and displayed on your page online!

Offline donations

As the fundraiser, if you recieve any donaitons offline, you will need to maintain financial records and ensure the timely deposit of those funds to AQ. Any fundraising activity you undertake will be conducted in your own name and is the sole responsibility of the fundraiser.

- It is a requirement that all fundraisers keep accurate financial records for the event or fundraising activity, including; expenses, income sources, bankingdetails and raffles.
- The proceeds of the fundraising activity and fundraising record form should be forwarded to AQ within four weeks of the conclusion of the event/ fundraising.
- AQ cannot pay any expenses associated with your event/ fundraising activity, nor can we be liable for any losses incurred if your event/ fundraising is cancelled for any reason or does not break even.
- You, the fundraiser, must take all reasonable steps to ensure that the
- expenses do not exceed a fair and reasonable proportion (no more than 30% of total income) of the gross proceeds obtained from the event.
